- Roadmap- Strategy matched with Operational work in the Field



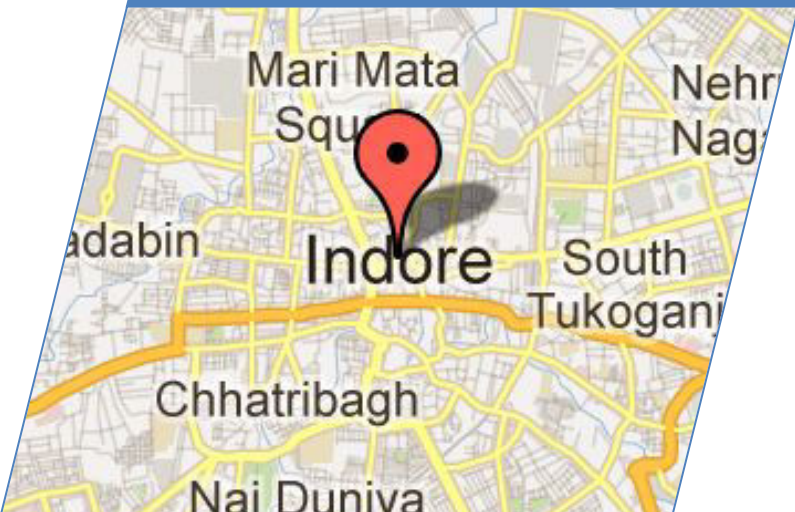
# Core Principles for TB Elimination and Self Reliance

- TB Elimination must be local (just as all politics is local)
- Follow a rapid cycle improvement collaborative quality improvement process
- Interventions must be sustainable - we are only catalysts
- Interventions must build local capacity
- Outcomes must be data driven and evidence based
- Use of technology essential to leapfrog improvements





# TB Elimination is local



- GOI has National Strategic Plan -NSP 2017-2025
- We need a local Roadmap
- We need local commitment
- What will Roadmap look like at a:
  - City level ( 3-10 million population)
  - District level ( 1-3 million)
  - Village level (10,000 to 100,000)

# Sustainability is key

- Help NGO write grant for government Public Private Partnership
- Encourage state government to fund NGO for activity
- Build capacity in other NGOs
